Nokia PC Suite Enterprise Edition

The PC Suite Enterprise Edition product will be discontinued after a final release at the end of 2010 as part of Nokia's efforts to streamline PC software.

Customers are advised to evaluate the solutions for mobile email on Nokia devices and consider new, easy-to-use solutions with over-the-air email and Personal Information management (PIM) synchronization.

Primarily, we encourage customers who currently use the PC Suite Enterprise Edition to sync their email and PIM information to evaluate the suitability of Mail for Exchange or Lotus Traveller to their needs. These solutions automatically push email and PIM information over-the-air so that employees can work on the move whether via cellular or wireless LAN technology.

In the future, synchronizing Microsoft Exchange email and PIM information via a USB connection will be supported in Ovi Suite. Ovi Suite is available via this deep link for automated installations

Customers are advised that Ovi Suite is not feature equivalent to the PC Suite Enterprise Edition and migration planning is recommended. Two key differences to the PC Suite Enterprise Edition are:

- Ovi Suite does not offer an installer where IT departments can customize what portions of Ovi Suite are installed
- As Ovi Suite contains 3rd party intellectual property, it needs to be downloaded from a Nokia distribution site by end users directly; and cannot be redistributed by IT departments
